We will be showing the works of Adam Adach, Ørnulf Opdahl, Kenneth Blom and Adrian Navarro.

Adam Adach (born 1962) is a Polish-French artist that we are showing for the first time. For large parts of the audience Adach will be well known through his cooperation with Bo Bjerregaard in Copenhagen and former Arndt & Partners in Berlin.

Ørnulf Opdahl (born 1944) is among Norway's most established contemporary painters. His landscapes are unequivocal in mood and colours.

Kenneth Blom (born 1967), belonging to the most renowned Norwegian painters, was the first contemporary artist ever to exhibit at Sotheby's in London. Blom's paintings dwell in the tense realm between figurative and abstract art.

Adrian Navarro (born 1973), a Spanish artist, lives and works in London. His paintings describe implosions of colours trapped inside virtual volumes that float weightlessly in the pictorial space.
